







THE ATP MASTERS 1000 IS A PREMIUM SERIES OF NINE TOURNAMENTS TAKING PLACE OVER THREE CONTINENTS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

As part of Phase One of ATP Tour's long term transformational Strategic Plan 'One Vision', two more ATP Masters 1000 events will move to 12 day events over the coming seasons, the format is currently already in use in Madrid, Rome, Shanghai, Indian Wells and Miami.

2023 saw the expansion of three of our Masters tournaments, from 7 to 12 days in duration. This continues for Canada and Cincinnati in 2025. This will mean a larger 96 man draw for some of ATP Tour's marquee events, bringing a wider talent draw and increased coverage for broadcast partners.









THE NITTO ATP FINALS IS THE YEAR-END FINALE TO THE ATP TOUR SEASON.

The event, which features the world's eight highest ranking singles players and doubles teams of the season, is contested in a round-robin format with the best four players and doubles teams reaching the knockout Semi-Finals stage.


The prestigious tournament has been contested in major cities around the world, with a rich history dating back to the birth of the Masters 1000 tournaments in Tokyo (1970). In November 2024, the tournament will be held in Turin for the fourth time in the events history.

COVERAGE

At the ATP Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals tournaments, all main draw singles and all main draw doubles matches are produced and made available to broadcasters.

WORLD FEED

Footage is available to clip and download. Broadcasters have a monthly archive allowance to promote their live coverage of the ATP Tour.










MEDIA PORTAL
