# The Open





# Championship Overview.

The Open is golf's original major and one of the world's most prestigious events.

Brian Harman was a runaway winner of The 151<sup>st</sup> Open, producing a magnificent performance at Royal Liverpool to become the Champion Golfer of the Year.

Harman triumphed by six shots over Jon Rahm, Jason Day, Sepp Straka and Tom Kim – a margin that demonstrated how brilliantly he handled the tests posed by the Hoylake links and a variety of different weather conditions.

In 2024, Royal Troon will host The 152<sup>nd</sup> Open. Troon's test begins with a gentle opening through some of the most striking links land to be found at any of The Open venues and concludes with a back nine as tough as any finish in the world. Troon most recently staged the Championship in 2016, when Henrik Stenson prevailed in a stunning duel with Phil Mickelson.

# AlG Women's Open





# Championship Overview.

The AIG Women's Open is a long-standing championship owned by The R&A and sanctioned by the Ladies' European Tour (LET) and the Ladies' Professional Golf Association (LPGA), and welcomes the highest calibre of golfers to compete. As one of only two women's majors played outside the US, the AIG Women's Open hosts the world's greatest golfers.

Lilia Vu was simply magnificent as she strode to a six-shot victory in the 2023 edition of the AIG Women's Open.

After opening with a two-over-par 72, the American moved through the gears over the weekend and, despite sharing the lead going into the final round, was eventually able to beat home favourite, Charley Hull, by a comfortable margin in an exciting battle.

The 2024 AIG Women's Open will take place at St Andrews, the home of golf, on the world's most famous links. Since first hosting the Championship in 2007, it has produced hugely entertaining, memorable weeks and worthy champions.

# The Senior Open

presented by Rolex







The Senior Open presented by Rolex has been part of the European Senior Tour (now Legends Tour) since 1987.

Jointly owned by The R&A and the European Tour Group and sanctioned by The R&A, the European Tour Group and the PGA Tour Champions, The Senior Open presented by Rolex is one of five men's senior major championships in golf and one of the most sought-after titles in the senior game.

In 2023, Alex Cejka defeated Padraig Harrington in a play-off to win The Senior Open presented by Rolex as he landed his third senior major championship on a dramatic day of punishing conditions, including howling winds and rain, at Royal Porthcawl.

Europe's only senior major championship will take place at Carnoustie Golf Links for the first time in eight years when the event returns to Scotland in 2024.

# The Amateur Championship









# Championship Overview.

The Amateur Championship is one of the biggest and most prestigious amateur events, providing an international platform for up-and-coming younger players.

Contested over stroke play and then match play, the championship provides important opportunities for all participants, as alongside winning the title, champions of this event secure exemptions into The Open and the US Open, and by tradition, an invitation to play in the Masters Tournament. Past Champions include Bobby Jones, Sergio Garcia and Jose Maria Olazabal, with the likes of Rory McIlroy, Tommy Fleetwood and Colin Montgomerie being among a highly successful group of past competitors.

In 2023, from an international field of 288 players representing 38 countries, South African Christo Lamprecht defeated Ronan Kleu from Switzerland in a thrilling contest, in front of large crowds on a glorious day, to win The 128<sup>th</sup> Amateur Championship at Hillside.

For the first time, the Irish links of Ballyliffin in County Donegal, which staged the 2018 Dubai Duty Free Irish Open, will host The Amateur Championship in 2024.

# The Women's Amateur Championship









# Championship Overview.

A proving ground for the stars of tomorrow, The Women's Amateur Championship provides an opportunity for the brightest female talents to display their ability on an international stage.

Along with the US Women's Amateur Golf Championship, it is considered the highest honour in women's amateur golf. The Championship, founded in 1893, attracts a top international field with an impressive list of former winners including McCormack Medal winner Leona Maguire and major champions Georgia Hall and Anna Nordqvist. The Champion gains entry to the AlG Women's Open, US Women's Open, The Amundi Evian Championship, Chevron Championship and by tradition, an invitation to compete at the Augusta National Women's Amateur Championship.

In 2023, Chiara Horder won The 120<sup>th</sup> Women's Amateur Championship after a convincing 7&6 win over Annabelle Pancake in the 36-hole Final at Prince's.

The 20-year-old became the third player from Germany to lift The Women's Amateur trophy in the last six years.

The 121st Women's Amateur Championship will be contested over the historic Irish links, Portmarnock, in 2024.

# The Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific



The Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific (WAAP) is the region's premier women's amateur golf championship.

The 2024 and sixth edition of the Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific (WAAP) championship will be played on the Waterside Course at the Siam Country Club in Thailand from 1-4 February 2024.

The WAAP returns to Siam Country Club following a successful championship in 2022 where a dramatic final round produced a memorable win for Ting-Hsuan Huang of Chinese Taipei.

The WAAP aims to inspire future generations of women golfers and provides the champion with a launchpad into international golf through exemptions to compete in three major championships; the AIG Women's Open, Amundi Evian Championship and the Chevron Championship. In addition, the champion will also be invited to the Hana Financial Group Championship, ISPS Handa Australian Open, The 121st Women's Amateur Championship and Augusta National Women's Amateur.

# Africa Amateur Championship









# Championship Overview.

The R&A is launching the Africa Amateur Championship to be played in 2024 at Leopard Creek.

The championship will feature 72 men from the African region competing in a 72-hole stroke play format with the winner receiving an exemption into The 152<sup>nd</sup> Open at Royal Troon.

An invitational event for 20 elite women from the region will also be held at the venue during the week of the championship.

The introduction of the new championship complements existing amateur championships jointly organised by The R&A in Asia-Pacific and Latin America and will enable players from Africa to play at the highest level, as well as creating a pathway for African golfers to develop and become an inspiration for others to follow.



# Curtis Cup







The Curtis Cup is the most prestigious team trophy for women amateur golfers and contested biennially by teams comprised of the leading women's amateur players representing Great Britain and Ireland and the United States of America.

First played in 1932, many well-known players have competed, including two-time winning Solheim Cup captain Catriona Matthew, Dame Laura Davies and AIG Women's Open Champion Georgia Hall.

Matthew, a member of three GB&I Curtis Cup teams, will captain Great Britain and Ireland in The 43<sup>rd</sup> Curtis Cup at Sunningdale in 2024. Signalling a new era for the GB&I side, she will bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to the role.
